Dear Crescent Lake Property Owners,

Help Needed: Boat Landing Volunteer Coordinator (Paid Position)

The Crescent Lake District has received a grant to continue our Clean Boats Clean Waters program for 2026. This is our most effective way to prevent the introduction of new invasive species into our lake.

Many of you have spent time doing boat inspections and talking with people who use our landing to educate them about invasive species. Thank you for those efforts and the time you've spent, it is essential for our success.

As part of that effort, we are looking for a person that can coordinate our volunteers. This is a paid position. The ideal person is someone connected to Crescent Lake that has time to monitor the internet sign up tool and try to fill as many shifts as possible. Our grant requires at least 200 volunteer hours over the summer (Memorial Day weekend thru Labor Day weekend). This requires sharing with our volunteers open shifts available and reporting volunteer hours into the DNR database. There are other minor tasks that require in-person attention, so a lake resident or frequent visitor is preferred.

Do you know anyone looking for such a part-time job for the summer? This role would be a great one for a person with some free time, or a college student looking to pick up some extra cash.
